### Position Summary

Reporting to the Chief Operating Officer Coastal Region, the Director of Care/Site Coordinator (DOC) is accountable for the effective and efficient functioning of patient care services. The DOC is responsible for providing leadership and direction for operations management, utilization, risk management and fostering quality care and patient safety at R.W. Large Memorial Hospital (RWLMH). In this key role the DOC will be developing a comprehensive framework for advancing quality care and patient safety in alignment with the hospital's organizational and strategic objectives. This includes implementing practice standards, continuous quality improvement strategy, patient safety, and performance measurement standards, as well as fostering a culture focused on excellence in health care delivery and patient safety.

The DOC plays a critical role in linking the portfolio with community health services to address the ongoing issues/needs of clients and their families and to ensure a smooth transition for the acute environment to appropriate services in the community or through transfers to services in the health authority. In addition to leading an inter-disciplinary team, works as a team player with colleagues and co-workers and in collaboration with key internal and external stakeholders to achieve excellence in client and family centered care, education and research. Building organizational capacity will be a priority for the incumbent.
