Position Summary

Family Medicine services for regular clinics and emergency call providing full service Family Practice to a primarily First Nations community. Services are augmented with visiting Specialists.

Qualifications

Family Practice GP – licensed for British Columbia or holding qualifications required to obtain BC licensure, CMPA, Emergency experience.

Ability to communicate effectively, both verbally and in writing. Ability to work independently, prioritize and organize work. Ability to deal with others effectively. Physical ability to carry out the duties of the position. Ability to operate related equipment

Benefits and Incentives:

Locums can choose either a Daily Rate option including travel reimbursement as per the Rural General Practitioner Locum Program guidelines, or a partial FTE Alternative Payment Plan (APP) Contract with The United Church Health Services Society. UCHSS Contracted physicians are not reimbursed travel costs, but are eligible for additional remuneration in accordance with the Rural Subsidiary Agreement (RSA) of 27.3% Retention Equivalent Premium (FPE). Benefits are administered by the Vancouver Coastal Health Authority and subject to MOH guidelines. Both payment options are eligible for MOCAP funds. Housing is provided close to facility.

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Facility

Under one roof is the clinic, the hospital and community health services. The medical clinic has 4 physician offices, separate exam rooms, and clinic support staff. The 15 bed acute/residential hospital includes Med/Surg, Residential and Emergency Room services. Community services include Home and Community Care, Public Health, Mental Health, Physiotherapy and Pharmacy. Serving a population of approximately 1800, including a First Nations community, some Integrated Health Services are provided with the Nuxalk Nation. We are affiliated with Vancouver Coastal Health.
